Advanced Health & Safety Certificate

Course Structure

The course runs for 5 days followed by a half day for the examination.

Candidates must be prepared to undertake 2 assignments in their own time, which will form part of the course assessment.

Assessment

Candidates are assessed on the basis of two course assignments and a three-hour written paper. The final pass mark is 60%. Those who gain a mark of 80% or more are awarded a credit certificate.

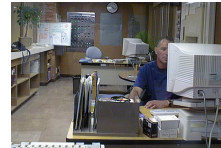
