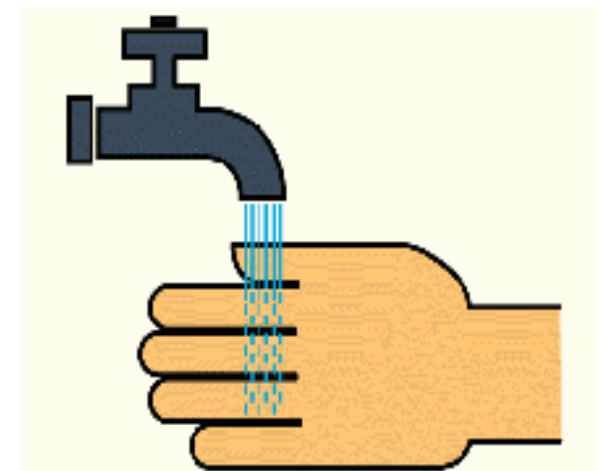

In the UK over a million people are employed as carers and millions more provide informal care and support for relatives and friends.
